Many of you will be aware of the tragedy of the terrorist attack in Pulawama, Kashmir leading to the death of over 40 Indian Soldiers. As faith leaders, we condemn acts of violence and terrorism like this that aim to divide the unity between different ethnic and faith groups.

The attack has caused pain and suffering to loved ones and many have been affected by it. Equally, there is tension among communities who are fearful of reprisals from people who are exploiting this tragedy to sow further division and hatred.

Our thoughts and prayers are with the victims and loved ones of those affected by this tragedy and pray that people stay united and promote the common universal values of peace, love and compassion and live as one human family.
